




## **IMPLEMENTATION**

French is the main language chosen at The Parkland Federation. This is one of our key neighbouring countries.

Our MFL programme was designed through liaison with invited specialists and links to our French reading scheme, 'Language Angels'. We also use supplementary material from "Luc et Sophie". As well as teaching core vocabulary, teachers are encouraged to work their way through the reading scheme with pupils to reinforce the well known relationship between language acquisition and reading. At the Infant School, children are introduced to key French vocabulary and salutations. They also learn familiar songs and rhymes in French.
